

ORDINANCE NO. 2372

AN ORDINANCE to amend the COMMUNITY FACILITIES ELEMENT of the "ADOPTED CONSOLIDATED MASTER PLAN OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, 1974."

WHEREAS, the city planning commission adopted a resolution on February 6, 1979, recommending that the "Recreation" section of the Community Facilities Element of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," be amended as follows; and

WHEREAS, the city council is of the opinion that the said plan should be amended as recommended by the city planning commission.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Community Facilities Element of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," which was adopted by Ordinance No. 1989 and amended by Ordinance No. 2243 and by Ordinance No. 2340, be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

a. All textual material and maps numbered 14 and 15 appearing in the "Recreation" section of the Community Facilities Element, pages 72 through 82, of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," are hereby deleted.

b. The text and maps contained in the "Recreation Amended Text," attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby adopted and made a part of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974."

c. The Park and Recreation Master Plan dated March, 1978, is hereby made an appendix to the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974."

d. Appendix VII of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," entitled "Capital Improvements Program 1971-1972," is hereby deleted from the said plan.

e. The Table of Contents of the "Adopted Consolidated Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1974," is hereby revised to reflect all those changes herein made to the said plan.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
