

ORDINANCE NO. 2430

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 32A-31 and 32A-32, Article VIII, Chapter 32A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 32A relates to SOLID WASTE CONTROL, which Article VIII relates to MISCELLANEOUS CHAPTER PROVISIONS, which Section 32A-31 relates to ENFORCEMENT OF CHAPTER and which Section 32A-32 relates to PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF CHAPTER.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 32A-31, Article VIII, Chapter 32A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 32A-31. Enforcement of chapter.

(a) The director of the department of transportation and environmental services or his authorized representative shall be responsible for, collect pursuant to and enforce the provisions of this chapter.

(b) The city manager may, upon the request of the director, allocate such resources and personnel of the city as the city manager may deem necessary to assist the director in the enforcement of such provisions of this chapter as the city manager shall specifically designate.

Section 2. That Section 32A-32, Article VIII, Chapter 32A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 32A-32. Penalty for violation of chapter.

Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
