

ORDINANCE NO. 2442

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-76, Article VII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article VII relates to PURCHASES AND CONTRACTUAL SERVICES and which Section 2-76 relates to APPOINTMENT, COMPENSATION AND QUALFICATIONS OF CITY PURCHASING AGENT; ASSISTANTS AND SUBORDINATES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-76, Article VII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-76. Appointment, compensation and qualifications of city purchasing agent; assistants and subordinates.

The city purchasing agent shall be appointed by the city manager. The city purchasing agent shall have had, prior to his appointment, at least three (3) years' experience in an executive capacity in a purchasing office or department. The compensation of the city purchasing agent shall be fixed from time to time by the city council.

The city manager, upon recommendation of the city purchasing agent, may appoint such assistants and subordinates in the purchasing division as may be necessary to properly carry out the purposes of this article, and their compensation shall be fixed from time to time by the council.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
