

ORDINANCE NO. 2456

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 22-98 and 22-98.1, Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article IV relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY, which Division 1 relates to IN GENERAL, which Section 22-98 formerly related to STOPPING CONTRARY TO DIRECTIONS OF SIGNS OR POLICE OFFICERS and now relates to STOPPING CONTRARY TO DIRECTIONS OF POLICE OFFICERS and which Section 22-98.1 formerly related to PERMITTING VEHICLE TO REMAIN PARKED AFTER EXPIRATION OF TIME LIMIT DESIGNATED BY OFFICIAL SIGN and now relates to PERMITTING VEHICLE TO REMAIN PARKED CONTRARY TO DIRECTIONS OF OFFICIAL SIGN.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-98, Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-98. Stopping contrary to directions of police officers.

It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, park or stand any vehicle in any place contrary to the directions of a police officer.

Section 2. That Section 22-98.1, Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-98.1. Permitting vehicle to remain parked contrary to the directions of official sign.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle or any person in whose name a vehicle is registered to cause, allow, permit or suffer a vehicle to remain in a parking space contrary to the directions of an official sign.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
