

ORDINANCE NO. 2462

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (b), Section 30-6, Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 30 relates to SITE PLANS, which Section 30-6 relates to EXCEPTIONS AS TO CERTAIN DWELLINGS, ETC. and which subsection (b) relates to ADDITIONS TO BUILDINGS.

THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (b), Section 30-6, Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(b) Additions to buildings where the total gross floor area of the proposed addition does not exceed one-third of the total gross floor area of the existing building or three thousand (3,000) square feet, whichever is smaller, or, where additions are proposed to two or more buildings located on the same lot, the aggregate proposed additions do not exceed one-third of the total gross floor areas of the existing buildings or three thousand (3,000) square feet, whichever is smaller.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
