

ORDINANCE NO. 2471

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (a), Section 37-6, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 37 relates to TAXICABS, ETC., FOR HIRE, which Section 37-6 relates to INSURANCE OR BOND REQUIRED and which subsection (a) relates to INSURANCE POLICY LIMITS FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 37-6, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) A public liability and property damage insurance policy in at least the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for death or injury to any one (1) person in any one (1) accident, and three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) for death or injury to more than one (1) person in any one (1) accident, and fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) property damage in any accident, all with a company authorized to do business within the state, and every policy under this section shall contain a clause obligating the company issuing the same to give fifteen (15) days' notice in writing to the hack inspector before any cancellation thereof.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
