

ORDINANCE NO. 2632

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the first paragraph of subsection 1-17(d), subsection 1-17(d)(4), the first paragraph of subsection 1-17(g), subsection 1-17(g)(1), the first paragraph of subsection 1-17(h), subsection 1-17(h)(1), all of Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which Section 1-17 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES, which first paragraph of subsection 1-17(d) relates to FOURTH WARD, which subsection 1-17(d)(4) formerly related to ROBERT E. LEE SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT and now relates to LEE CENTER ELECTION DISTRICT, which first paragraph of subsection 1-17(g) relates to SEVENTH WARD, which subsection 1-17(g)(1) formerly related to THE MINNIE HOWARD SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT and now relates to ALEXANDRIA SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION OFFICE ELECTION DISTRICT, which first paragraph of subsection 1-17(h) relates to EIGHTH WARD and which subsection 1-17(h)(1) formerly related to THE JOHN TYLER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT and now relates to THE JOHN TYLER BUILDING ELECTION DISTRICT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first paragraph of subsection (d), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(d) Fourth Ward. MacArthur School Election District and voting place; Second Presbyterian Church Election District and voting place; Lyceum Election District and voting place; Lee Center Election District and voting place. The fourth ward shall be divided into MacArthur School Election District, Second Presbyterian Church Election District, Lyceum Election District and Lee Center Election District.

Section 2. That subsection (4), subsection (d), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(4) The Lee Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to its end; thence westward along a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street to the centerline of Hooffs Run; thence southward along the centerline of Hooff's Run to the southern city boundary; thence eastward

along such boundary to the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Washington Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Lee Center Election District shall be at the Lee Center, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Patrick Street and Jefferson Street.

Section 3. That the first paragraph of subsection (g), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(g) Seventh Ward. Alexandria School Administration Office Election District and voting place; Francis Hammond High School Election District and voting place; James K. Polk School Election District and voting place; Patrick Henry School Election District and voting place; Engine Company No. 8 Firehouse Election District and voting place; Trade Center Election District and voting place; Temple Beth El Election District and voting place. The seventh ward shall be divided into the Alexandria School Administration Office Election District, the Francis Hammond High School Election District, the James K. Polk School Election District, the Patrick Henry School Election District, the Engine Company No. 8 Firehouse Election District, the Trade Center Election District and the Temple Beth El Election District.

Section 4. That subsection (1), subsection (g), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(1) The Alexandria School Administration Office Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of North Quaker Lane and Seminary Road; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the Arlington County line to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of such highway to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Alexandria School Administration Office Election District shall be the Alexandria School Administration Office, located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Braddock Road and North Early Street.

Section 5. That the first paragraph of subsection (h), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria,

Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(h) Eighth Ward. John Tyler Building Election District and voting place; William Ramsay School Election District and voting place; John Adams Middle School Election District and voting place; Southern Towers Election District and voting place. The eighth ward shall be divided into the John Tyler Building Election District, the William Ramsay School Election District, the John Adams Middle School Election District and the Southern Towers Election District.

Section 6. That subsection (1), subsection (h), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(1) The John Tyler Building Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Seminary Road with the centerline of North Beauregard Street; thence northward along the centerline of North Beauregard Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence south along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the Arlington County line to the western boundary of the city; thence southward along the western boundary of the city to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the John Tyler Building Election District shall be the John Tyler Building, located at 3101 North Beauregard Street.

Section 7. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting.

This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
