

ORDINANCE NO. 2637

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 37-83, Division 6, Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 37 relates to TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE, which Article I relates to TAXICABS AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLES, which Division 6 relates to FARES and which Section 37-83 relates to CARRYING SEVERAL PASSENGERS TO DIFFERENT DESTINATIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 37-83, Division 6, Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 37-83. Carrying several passengers to different destinations.

In cases where more than one passenger enters a taxicab at the same time, bound for different destinations, the fare shall be as follows: Whenever a passenger gets out and pays the fare, the meter shall be reset upon that passenger's departure, but when passengers getting out do not pay the fare, the meter shall not be reset and the full fare shall be paid by the last passenger delivered.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
