

ORDINANCE NO. 2641

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (e), Section 2-47.1.7, Division 3, Article II, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article II relates to OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES GENERALLY, which Division 3 relates to BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, COMMITTEES, AUTHORITIES AND SIMILAR BODIES, which Section 2-47.1.7 relates to APPOINTMENTS TO COMMITTEES, which subsection (e) relates to APPOINTMENT OF PERSON HOLDING OFFICE OR POSITION IN THE CITY FOR COMPENSATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (e), Section 2-47.1.7, Division 3, Article II, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(e) No person who holds any office or position in the City of Alexandria for compensation shall be appointed to any committee which is involved in, responsible for, oversees or regulates the subject matter, policy or rules of the city department or agency by which the person is employed. The executive secretary shall review all applications for appointments to committees. The executive secretary shall advise the council whether, in his or her opinion, the appointment of the person to the committee for which application has been made would result in such a situation.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
