

ORDINANCE NO. 2666

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 22-139, Division 2, Article V, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by deleting subsection (a) and renumbering the remaining subsections as (a) and (b); which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article V relates to PARKING METERS, which Division 2 relates to METERED PARKING LOTS and which Section 22-139 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF METERED PARKING LOTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-139, Division 2, Article V, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by deleting subsection (a) and renumbering the remaining subsections to read as follows:

(a) All of that parcel of land in the city designated Municipal Parking Lot No. 2, located on the south side of King Street between Alfred and Patrick Streets.

(b) All of that parcel of land in the city designated Municipal Parking Lot No. 3 by the city manager, being a portion of Lot No. 1, Block 3, Map 149 of the City of Alexandria's Assessment Records, which Lot No. 1, Block 3 of the said Map 149 consists of 1.15 acres, more or less, and is bounded on the north by Queen Street, on the east side by Union Street, on the south by Thompson's Alley and on the west by Lee Street.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
