

ORDINANCE NO. 2670

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (e), Section 11-7-9, Chapter 7, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 11 relates to HEALTH, ENVIRONMENTAL AND SANITARY REGULATIONS, which Chapter 7 relates to PERSONAL GROOMING ESTABLISHMENTS, which Section 11-7-9 relates to PREMISES, FACILITIES AND APPARATUS and which subsection (e) formerly related to WATER CLOSET FACILITIES and now relates to PLUMBING FACILITIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (e), Section 11-7-9, Chapter 7, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(e) No person shall use any building or part of any building as a personal grooming establishment unless the building or part thereof is provided with plumbing facilities installed in accordance with law. If the facilities can be reached by a line of travel not exceeding 25 meters without going outside of the building they shall be deemed sufficient for the purposes of this subsection. The facilities shall be provided with an adequate supply of toilet tissues, paper towels and soap.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective on and after May 1, 1982.
