

ORDINANCE NO. 2672

AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding a new section numbered 22-115.2; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article IV relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY, which Division 1 relates to IN GENERAL and which new Section 22-115.2 relates to INTERFERING WITH ENFORCEMENT OF CHAPTER.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 22-115.2 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-115.2. Interfering with enforcement of chapter.

It shall be unlawful to erase, remove or cover up any chalk mark placed for identification purposes upon any vehicle by any parking enforcement officer enforcing the provisions of article IV, article IV-A or article V of this chapter without removing such vehicle from a parking space in such a manner that the space is completely vacated by that vehicle.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
