

ORDINANCE NO. 2676

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 42-25.8, Article IV-B, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article IV-B relates to FLOODPLAIN DISTRICTS and which Section 42-25.8 relates to FLOODPLAIN DISTRICTS CREATED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 42-25.8, Article IV-B, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 42-25.8. Floodplain districts created.

There are hereby established floodplain districts throughout the city as shown on a map entitled "Flood Plain Map, The City of Alexandria, Alexandria, Virginia," dated April 30, 1982, signed by the mayor, the chairman of the planning commission and the director of transportation and environmental services, which map is on file in the offices of the director of transportation and environmental services and director of planning and community development, respectively. Said floodplain district map is hereby made a part of this article, and such map and all notations, references and other data shown thereon are by this reference made a part hereof as if fully described herein. Any changes in said map are subject to approval by the Federal Insurance Administration of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development prior to becoming effective and such approval shall be evidenced by notice in writing from the federal insurance administrator or his authorized representative.

Any uncertainty on said map with respect to the boundary of any floodplain district, either A or B zone as hereinafter defined, shall be determined by the director of transportation and environmental services by scaling and computation from the map.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second

reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective on and after April 30, 1982.
