

ORDINANCE NO. 2682

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (32), Section 7-6-1, Article A, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article A relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS; which Section 7-6-1 relates to DEFINITIONS and which subsection (32) relates to FAMILY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (32), Section 7-6-1, Article A, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(32) Family. A group of people living together consisting of:

(a) One (1) or more persons related by blood or marriage together with any number of natural, foster, step or adopted children, domestic servants, nurses and therapists and not more than two (2) roomers or boarders; or

(b) Not more than four (4) unrelated persons; or

(c) Any other housekeeping unit not defined above which may be approved through the issuance of a special use permit as specified in sections 7-6-191 through 7-6-195 of this Code as being compatible with the character of the neighborhood in which it is to be located; provided, however, that such housekeeping unit shall not exceed nine (9) persons.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the

second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
