

ORDINANCE NO. 2686

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7-6-1, Article A, by adding a new subsection numbered (77.1); and to amend Section 7-6-72, Division 1, Article E, by adding new subsections numbered (12) and (13), all of Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article A relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which Section 7-6-1 relates to DEFINITIONS, which new subsection (77.1) relates to VALET PARKING, which Article E relates to OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING, which Division 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which Section 7-6-72 relates to OFF-STREET PARKING GENERALLY, which new subsection (12) relates to VALET PARKING and which new subsection (13) relates to REDUCTION OF PARKING REQUIREMENTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 7-6-1, Article A, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new subsection numbered (77.1) to read as follows:

(77.1) Valet parking. The provision of parking for vehicles whereby vehicles are parked and unparked in the parking area, parking lot or any parking structure by a person other than the owner or operator of the vehicle.

Section 2. That Section 7-6-72, Division 1, Article E, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding new subsections numbered (12) and (13) to read as follows:

(12) The requirements of subsection (4) above shall not apply to valet parking facilities when city-approved valet parking is provided.

(13) The requirements of subsection (11) above may be reduced when special zoning allows parking reductions and the required approvals of the director of planning and community development and the director of transportation and environmental services have been obtained and the conditions of said approval are complied with.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall

note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
