

ORDINANCE NO. 2690

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection a, subsection (b)(1), Section 2-4-21, Article B, Chapter 4, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 2 relates to GENERAL GOVERNMENT, which Chapter 4 relates to COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, which Article B relates to ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES COMMISSION and which Section 2-4-21 relates to CREATION, COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection a, subsection (b)(1), Section 2-4-21, Article B, Chapter 4, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

a. Elected public officials (category I). Of the six (6) elected public officials, four (4) shall be members of the city council and two (2) shall be from the following elected officials who represent residents of Alexandria: members of the United States Congress, Virginia state senators, Virginia state delegates, commonwealth's attorney or sheriff. In the event a specified public official elects to serve on the commission, such official may designate a permanent representative to serve in his or her place or select an alternate to represent the official when he or she is unable to attend a meeting. Such representative shall serve at the pleasure of the public official making the designation, but in no event shall such representative serve for a greater term than the official making the appointment. A representative or alternate must be a resident of the city. For the purposes of category I appointments, the requirements of section 2-4-7(b) and (c) are waived.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
