

ORDINANCE NO. 2730

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 1, Title 6 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, by adding a new section numbered 6-1-4; which Title 6 relates to PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES, which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS and which new section numbered 6-1-4 relates to USE OF RADIOS, TAPE PLAYERS OR OTHER ELECTRONIC SOUND-PRODUCING DEVICES WITHOUT INDIVIDUAL HEADSETS OR EARPHONES IN BEVERLY PARK PROHIBITED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 1, Title 6 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 6-1-4 to read as follows:

Sec. 6-1-4. Use of radios, tape players or other electronic sound-producing devices without individual headsets or earphones in Beverly Park prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any radio, tape player or other electronic sound-producing device without the use of individual headsets or earphones that limit the sound produced to the individual user at any place within the city's park known as Beverly Park located at North and South Overlook Drives in the city.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
