

ORDINANCE NO. 2735

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3-2-327 by adding subsection (b) and to amend Section 3-2-329 by adding subsection (b), all of Article R, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 3 relates to FINANCE, TAXATION AND PROCUREMENT, which Chapter 2 relates to TAXATION, which Article R relates to LICENSE TAX ON MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAILERS AND SEMITRAILERS, which Section 3-2-327 relates to TAX ON VEHICLES USED FOR TRANSPORTATION--SCHEDULE, which subsection (b) relates to VIRGINIA NATIONAL GUARD LICENSE PLATE FEE, which Section 3-2-329 relates to TAX ON VEHICLES NOT DESIGNED OR USED FOR TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS and which subsection (b) relates to VIRGINIA NATIONAL GUARD LICENSE PLATE FEE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 3-2-327, Article R, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding subsection (b) to read as follows:

(b) Provided that the license fees for passenger vehicles owned by members of the Virginia National Guard shall be one-half (1/2) of the license fees prescribed in this section, upon presentation of evidence by the registered owners that special Virginia National Guard license plates have been issued to the vehicles as provided in section 46.1-105.9 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

Section 2. That Section 3-2-329, Article R, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding subsection (b) to read as follows:

(b) Provided that the license fees for pickup trucks and panel trucks owned by members of the Virginia National Guard shall be one-half (1/2) of the license fees prescribed in this section, upon presentation of evidence by registered owners that special Virginia National Guard license plates have been issued to the vehicles as provided in section 46.1-105.9 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of

publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
