

ORDINANCE NO. 2742

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-5-34 by lettering the first paragraph (a) and adding a new subsection (b), Article C, Chapter 5, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 2 relates to GENERAL GOVERNMENT, which Chapter 5 relates to OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, which Article C relates to ETHICS, which Section 2-5-34 relates to REPRESENTATION OF PRIVATE INTERESTS, which new subsection lettered (a) relates to NO REPRESENTATION BY PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES and which new subsection (b) relates to PROHIBITION TO APPEAR BEFORE BOARD OR COMMISSION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-5-34, Article C, Chapter 5, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained by lettering the first paragraph (a) and adding a new subsection (b) to read as follows:

Sec. 2-5-34. Representation of private interests.

(a) No public official or employee shall act as attorney, agent, broker or employee for any person, directly or indirectly, in dealings with the agency with which the public official or employee serves.

(b) No member of any board or commission in the city service shall appear as the representative of any person in any matter before the board or commission of which he is a member. Anything in section 2-5-4 of this code to the contrary notwithstanding, this prohibition shall apply to all members of all city boards and commissions whether they consent hereto in writing or not.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
