

ORDINANCE NO. 2761

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection b, subsection (2), subsection (b), Section 5-8-93, Division 1, Article G, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 8 relates to PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, which Article G relates to PARKING METERS, which Division 1 relates to PARKING METER ZONES, which Section 5-8-93 relates to TIME LIMITS; WHEN METERS TO BE IN OPERATION; COINS DEPOSITED, which subsection (b) relates to HOURS AND DAYS OF OPERATION FOR PARKING METER ZONE 2, which subsection (2) relates to TIME LIMITS FOR PARKING IN ZONE 2 and which subsection b relates to PARKING METERS WITH TWO-HOUR LIMIT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection b, subsection (2), subsection (b), Section 5-8-93, Division 1, Article G, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

b. Any period of time up to two (2) hours in those areas limited to two- (2) hour parking for ten cents (\$.10) for each 15-minute period or any portion thereof, and one (1) or more nickels, dimes or quarters or combination thereof for any period of time up to two (2) hours at the rate of ten cents (\$.10) for each 15-minute period or portion thereof.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
