

ORDINANCE NO. 2769

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 8-1-13, Article B, Chapter 1, Title 8 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 8 relates to BUILDING CODE REGULATIONS, which Chapter 1 relates to BUILDING CODE, which Article B relates to MISCELLANEOUS CONDITIONS OF PERMITS and which Section 8-1-13 relates to PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS--PROVISIONS FOR CONTROL OF CONTAMINATED LAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 8-1-13, Article B, Chapter 1, Title 8 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 8-1-13. Plans and specifications--Provisions for control of contaminated land.

In documentation accompanying the application for the permit, provisions for the control of contaminated land, in accordance with the city code, Administrative Procedures for Control of Contaminated Land dated October 20, 1976, and ordinance no. 2135 adopted by council November 23, 1976, and as they may be amended from time to time, shall be described when the site is in an area contaminated by a toxic substance and hazardous to the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
