

ORDINANCE NO. 2789

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (c), Section 5-7-3, Article A, Chapter 7, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 7 relates to ANIMALS AND FOWL, which Article A relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which Section 5-7-3 relates to KEEPING LIVESTOCK and which subsection (c) relates to EXEMPTIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 5-7-3, Article A, Chapter 7, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(c) This section shall not apply to livestock which are brought into and taken from the city within a 24-hour period and used for business purposes or livestock housed in the city for the purpose of historical carriage tours; provided, however, that all livestock used for carriage tours shall be subject to regulations established by the city manager which regulate the housing, maintenance and general working conditions of such animals.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
