

ORDINANCE NO. 2879

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (2), subsection (b), Section 5-8-92, Division 1, Article G, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 8 relates to PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, which Article G relates to PARKING METERS, which Division 1 relates to PARKING METER ZONES, which Section 5-8-92 relates to PARKING METER ZONES ESTABLISHED, which subsection (b) relates to PARTS OF STREETS ESTABLISHED AS PARKING METER ZONE 2 and which subsection (2) relates to PARKING METERS ON FAYETTE, WEST, KING AND PAYNE STREETS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (2), subsection (b), Section 5-8-92, Division 1, Article G, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(2) Both sides of the 100, 800 and 900 blocks of North Fayette Street and the east side of North West Street. The east side of the 600 and 700 blocks of North Fayette Street. The east side of South Fayette Street for a distance of 120 feet south of the south curb line of King Street and the west side of the 100 block of South Fayette Street for a distance of 215 feet south of the south curb line of King Street. Both sides of the 100 block of North Payne Street, except the portion between Cameron Street and the alley which is 100 feet north of King Street.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
