

ORDINANCE NO. 2891

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (c), Section 9-1-60, Article B; and to repeal subsection (a.1), Section 9-1-75, Article C, all of Chapter 1, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 9 relates to LICENSING AND REGULATION, which Article B relates to REGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 9-1-60 relates to PEDDLERS, which subsection (c) relates to PRORATION, which Article C relates to NONREGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 9-1-75 relates to RETAIL MERCHANTS--GENERALLY and which subsection (a.1) formerly related to MAXIMUM TAX RATE FOR PEDDLERS AT RETAIL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (c), Section 9-1-60, Article B, Chapter 1, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(c) The license tax imposed under this section shall not be prorated, notwithstanding the provisions of section 9-1-20.

Section 2. That subsection (a.1), Section 9-1-75, Article C, Chapter 1, Title 9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
