

ORDINANCE NO. 2894

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection b, subsection (2), Section 7-6-192 by adding two new subsubsubsections numbered 10 and 11, all of Article J, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article J relates to SPECIAL USE PERMITS, which Section 7-6-192 relates to PROCEDURE AS TO ISSUANCE, which subsection (2) relates to INFORMATION INCLUDED IN APPLICATIONS FOR SPECIAL USE PERMIT, which subsubsection b relates to APPLICANT PLANS TO CONTROL POTENTIAL IMPACTS, which new subsubsubsection 10 relates to HAZARDOUS MATERIALS and which new subsubsubsection 11 relates to ORGANIC COMPOUNDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsubsection b, subsection (2), Section 7-6-192, Article J, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding two new subsubsubsections numbered 10 and 11 to read as follows:

10. Hazardous materials. Identification, monthly quantity and specific disposal method of any state or federally defined hazardous materials or waste to be handled, stored, processed or generated on the property.

11. Organic compounds. Identification, monthly quantity and specific disposal method of any paint, ink or lacquer thinner, cleaning or degreasing solvent to be handled, stored, processed or generated on the property.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
