

ORDINANCE NO. 2962

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 5-8-71 by adding a new subsection numbered (4) and redesignating the subsequent subsections as (5) and (6), and to amend and reordain subsection (5), Section 5-8-74, all of Article F, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 8 relates to PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, which Article F relates to PERMIT PARKING DISTRICTS, which Section 5-8-71 relates to DEFINITIONS, which new subsection (4) relates to PERSON, which Section 5-8-74 relates to PARKING PERMITS; ISSUANCE and which subsection (5) relates to PERMIT INVALIDITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 5-8-71, Article F, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new subsection numbered (4) to read as follows and redesignating the subsequent subsections as (5) and (6):

(4) Person. A natural, not corporate, person who resides in a dwelling located within the boundaries of a permit parking district.

Section 2. That subsection (5), Section 5-8-74, Article F, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(5) Whenever the holder of a permit issued pursuant to this section would no longer be qualified to obtain such permit, the permit shall no longer be valid. Whenever any permit becomes invalid prior to its expiration date, the holder of the permit shall surrender it to the city manager or his authorized representative. Provided, however, that no permit holder with a permit validly issued under section 5-8-74 prior to June 26, 1984, shall be required to surrender such permit under the terms of this subsection prior to the permit expiration date of April 30, 1985.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second

reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
