

ORDINANCE NO. 3027

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 7-6-289, Article O, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article O relates to AMENDMENTS, ETC. and which Section 7-6-289 relates to LIMITATION ON FREQUENCY OF PUBLIC HEARINGS BEFORE COUNCIL AS TO CHANGES IN ZONE BOUNDARIES AND ZONING REGULATIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 7-6-289, Article O, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 7-6-289. Limitation on frequency of public hearings before council as to changes in zone boundaries and zoning regulations.

Public hearings before the city council in relation to the determination of zone boundaries shall not be held more frequently than once every two (2) months; provided, that more frequent rezoning ordinances may be enacted under the emergency ordinance provision of the charter. Public hearings before the city council in relation to the adoption, supplement, amendment, alteration or change of regulations and restrictions shall not be subject to these time constraints.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
