

ORDINANCE NO. 3036

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection (a), Section 13-1-37 by adding a new subsection (10) and redesignating the subsequent subsections as (11) and (12), all of Chapter 1, Title 13 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 13 relates to MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES, which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL OFFENSES, which Section 13-1-37 relates to WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY BUSES, RAIL TRANSIT CARS AND RAIL TRANSIT STATIONS AND SCHOOL BUSES--PROHIBITED CONDUCT, which subsection (a) relates to PROHIBITED CONDUCT and which subsection (10) relates to FAILURE TO PAY FARES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 13-1-37, Chapter 1, Title 13 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new subsection (10) to read as follows and redesignating the subsequent subsections as (11) and (12):

(10) To knowingly board a public passenger vehicle of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority or Alexandria Transit Company which is transporting passengers in regular route service, without paying the established fare, board a rail transit car or enter the paid area of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority rail system without the farecard required for such entry and boarding or leaving the paid area without having presented a valid farecard or otherwise paying the established fare or boarding without presenting a valid transfer or pass for transportation on a public transit passenger vehicle or on a rail transit car.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
