

ORDINANCE NO. 3038

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 11-1-3, Chapter 1, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 11 relates to HEALTH, ENVIRONMENTAL AND SANITARY REGULATIONS, which Chapter 1 relates to AIR POLLUTION CONTROL and which Section 11-1-3 formerly related to ADOPTION OF MODIFIED STATE REGULATIONS and now relates to ADOPTION OF STATE REGULATIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 11-1-3, Chapter 1, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 11-1-3. Adoption of state regulations.

Parts III, IV, V and VI of the Commonwealth of Virginia State Air Pollution Control Board Regulations for the Control and Abatement of Air Pollution effective January 1, 1985, which prescribe air pollution standards, are hereby incorporated by reference. Those regulations shall have the same force and effect as the provisions of this chapter, and the penalty for violation of any provision of the regulations shall be the same as the penalty for a violation of a provision of this chapter. The director shall certify a true copy of the regulations and file them with the city manager for public inspection at reasonable times.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
