

ORDINANCE NO. 3048

AN ORDINANCE to redesignate Section 6-1-4 as 6-1-5, and to amend Chapter 1 by adding a new Section 6-1-4 thereto, all of Chapter 1, Title 6 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 6 relates to PARKS, RECREATION AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES, which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which new Section 6-1-4 relates to MARKET SQUARE--USE OR OPERATION OF MOPEDS OR MOTOR VEHICLES, AND WILLFUL AND MALICIOUS DAMAGE OR DEFACEMENT OF PUBLIC FACILITIES PROHIBITED, and which redesignated Section 6-1-5 relates to USE OF RADIOS, TAPE PLAYERS OR OTHER ELECTRONIC SOUND-PRODUCING DEVICES WITHOUT INDIVIDUAL HEADSETS OR EARPHONES IN BEVERLY PARK PROHIBITED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 6-1-4, Chapter 1, Title 6 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is redesignated as 6-1-5.

Section 2. That Chapter 1, Title 6 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 6-1-4 to read as follows:

Sec. 6-1-4. Market Square--Use or operation of mopeds or motor vehicles, and willful and malicious damage or defacement of public facilities prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any person to use or operate any moped or any vehicle, as defined in section 46.1-1, Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, or for any person to willfully or maliciously injure or deface any real or personal property of the city or property lawfully on display or loaned to the city, at any place within the city's public area known as Market Square, which square lies between the 100 blocks of North Royal and North Fairfax Streets, bounded on the south side by King Street and on the north by city hall; provided that such square has been posted with signs that indicate that the use or operation of mopeds or motor vehicles is prohibited; provided further, that this section shall not be construed to prohibit public employees or their duly authorized agents to use or operate motor vehicles in Market Square in the performance of their duties.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall

note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
