

ORDINANCE NO. 3066

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (38), Section 7-6-1, Article A, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article A relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS, which Section 7-6-1 relates to DEFINITIONS and which subsection (38) relates to GROUP HOME.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (38), Section 7-6-1, Article A, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(38) **Group home.** A building or portion thereof for which a permit has been issued when required by law, to be occupied by not more than nine (9) persons; provided, however, that for every two (2) children under the age of seven (7) and living with their parent, only one (1) person shall be counted; provided further, that there shall be a maximum of eight (8) such children (equaling four (4) persons), designed primarily for domiciliary use, but which may also be used for limited medical, psychological or similar care. The term "group home" shall not include children's or foster homes subject to title 12, chapter 3 of this code.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
