

ORDINANCE NO. 3080

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 10-4-8, and to add two new sections numbered 10-4-38 and 10-4-39, all of Chapter 4, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 10 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Chapter 4 relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING, which new Section 10-4-39 relates to TEMPORARY PARKING PROHIBITED, which new Section 10-4-38 relates to PARKING WITHOUT DISPLAY OF CURRENT STATE INSPECTION STICKER OR CURRENT STATE LICENSE PLATE and which Section 10-4-8 relates to PARKING FOR MORE THAN 72 CONTINUOUS HOURS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 10-4-8, Chapter 4, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 10-4-8. Parking for more than 72 continuous hours.

Unless otherwise controlled by an official sign, the parking of any vehicle in the same place on the streets of the city for more than 72 continuous hours is prohibited; provided that this provision shall not apply to the parking of a vehicle in the same place on the streets of the city on Saturday, Sunday and holidays.

Section 2. That Chapter 4, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 10-4-38 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-4-38. Parking without display of current state inspection sticker or current state license plate.

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer controlled by him upon the streets of this city unless the motor vehicle is currently inspected and licensed in accordance with the provisions of the motor vehicle laws of the jurisdiction in which the vehicle is licensed.

Section 3. That Chapter 4, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 10-4-39 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-4-39. Temporary parking prohibited.

(1) It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle on the streets of this city in violation of temporary no parking provisions. When

parking is temporarily prohibited under this section, the director of transportation and environmental services shall direct to be posted temporary no parking signs which shall be of such character as to inform a readily observant person of the existence of such temporary no parking regulations.

(2) The city manager is hereby authorized and directed to promulgate regulations to control the posting of temporary no parking signs so as to avoid pedestrian or vehicular delays or disruption due to the use and operation of city streets, bridges, alleys, tracks, poles, wires, cables, pipes, conduits, subways, or vaults or other rights-of-way for any of the following purposes:

- (a) construction;
- (b) repairs and maintenance;
- (c) funerals;
- (d) parades;
- (e) city-permitted neighborhood events; and

(f) other purposes required for the daily operation of city transportation and environmental services.

Such rules and regulations shall designate the types of activities for which such temporary no parking signs shall apply and shall prescribe the time when such restrictions shall be in effect.

Section 4. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
