

ORDINANCE NO. 3122

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 11-6-13, Chapter 6, Title 11 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 11 relates to HEALTH, ENVIRONMENTAL AND SANITARY REGULATIONS, which Chapter 6 relates to RAT CONTROL and which Section 11-6-13 relates to RAT GUARDS AT WHARVES, DOCKS AND SLIPS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 11-6-13, Chapter 6, Title 13 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 11-6-13. Rat guards at wharves, docks and slips.

All public and private docks and wharves in the city wherever located shall be protected so as to prevent rats from gaining entrance to such docks or wharves at either high or low tide from vessels anchored or moored alongside of the docks or wharves. Rat guards shall be immediately placed on all lines used to secure any vessel alongside any dock or wharf. This section shall not apply to any vessels authorized, under title 6, chapter 3 of the city code, to be docked at the City of Alexandria Marina.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
