

ORDINANCE NO. 3131

AN ORDINANCE appropriating funds from the sale of surplus city real property (Metro site in the Cameron Run Valley and the Torpedo Factory site) from capital program reserve funds, which funds are unencumbered and unappropriated.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate to the fund hereinafter named certain funds from the sale of surplus city real property: Metro site in the Cameron Run Valley, \$861,485.00, and the Torpedo Factory site, \$138,515.00, from capital program reserve funds, which funds have heretofore been unencumbered and unappropriated as follows:

Section 2. That these funds be applied to the following projects:

Chinquapin Recreation Center	\$830,000.00
Construction of Public Space Improvements at the Torpedo Factory waterfront area.	\$170,000.00

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
