

ORDINANCE NO. 3141

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsections (20), (21), (22) and (23), subsection (a), Section 3-2-354, Article S, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 3 relates to FINANCE, TAXATION AND PROCUREMENT, which Chapter 2 relates to TAXATION, which Article S relates to PAYMENT, CONTEST AND ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING CITATIONS, which Section 3-2-354 relates to PENALTIES FOR UNCONTESTED PARKING CITATIONS, which subsection (a) relates to TENDERING PAYMENT WITHIN 30 CALENDAR DAYS FROM DATE CITATION ISSUED, which subsection (23) relates to VIOLATION OF SECTION 10-4-25, which subsection (22) relates to VIOLATION OF SECTION 10-4-24, which subsection (21) relates to VIOLATION OF SECTION 10-4-23 and which subsection (20) relates to VIOLATION OF SECTION 10-4-22.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (20), subsection (a), Section 3-2-354, Article S, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(20) \$10 for a violation of section 10-4-22, "How meter and space to be used;"

Section 2. That subsection (21), subsection (a), Section 3-2-354, Article S, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(21) \$10 for a violation of section 10-4-23, "Overtime parking;"

Section 3. That subsection (22), subsection (a), Section 3-2-354, Article S, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(22) \$10 for a violation of section 10-4-24, "Depositing coin in meter for purpose of extending time;"

Section 4. That subsection (23), subsection (a), Section 3-2-354, Article S, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(23) \$10 for a violation of section 10-4-25, "Permitting vehicle to remain parked at meter after expiration of time limit;"

Section 5. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1986.
