

ORDINANCE NO. 3150

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 3-2-181, Division 1, Article M, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 3 relates to FINANCE, TAXATION AND PROCUREMENT, which Chapter 2 relates to TAXATION, which Article M relates to LEVY AND COLLECTION OF PROPERTY TAXES, which Division 1 relates to REAL ESTATE and which Section 3-2-181 relates to LEVIED; AMOUNT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 3-2-181, Division 1, Article M, Chapter 2, Title 3 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 3-2-181. Levied; amount.

There shall be levied and collected on all real estate located within the territorial boundaries of the city subject to taxation for city purposes under the constitution and laws of this state and city an annual tax calculated on the basis of a tax rate of \$1.38 on each \$100.00 of assessed value thereof for the first six (6) months of calendar year 1986 and a tax rate of \$1.37 on each \$100 of assessed value thereof for the second six (6) months of calendar year 1986, such annual tax being for the support of the city government, for the payment of principal and interest of the city debt and for other municipal expenses and purposes.

Section 2. No change in the rate of the real estate tax for 1986 enacted after June 15, 1986, shall affect the amount of tax installment to be or to have been paid on or before June 15, 1986, under section 3-2-182 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, the levy for which remains at \$1.38 on each \$100.00 of assessed value of the real estate.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
