

ORDINANCE NO. 3172

AN ORDINANCE appropriating amounts from the sale of surplus city real property (John Roberts site and Torpedo Factory site) from the capital program reserve account, which amounts are unencumbered and unappropriated.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate to the account hereinafter named certain amounts from the sale of surplus city real property (John Roberts site and the Torpedo Factory site) from the capital program reserve account, which amounts have heretofore been unencumbered and unappropriated as follows:

Section 2. That these amounts be applied to the following projects:

Progress payment to Virginia Department of Highways & Transportation for construction of the Monroe Street bridge	\$200,000.00
Renovation of existing structures	\$300,000.00
Mt. Vernon Avenue streetscaping	\$400,000.00
Storm sewer reconstruction	\$100,000.00

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
