

ORDINANCE NO. 3182

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-1-4, Article A, Chapter 1, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 2 relates to GENERAL GOVERNMENT, which Chapter 1 relates to THE CITY COUNCIL, which Article A relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS and which Section 2-1-4 relates to COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-1-4, Article A, Chapter 1, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-1-4. Compensation of members.

The mayor shall receive, in full compensation for his services, the salary of \$25,000 per year. The members of city council shall receive, in full compensation for their services, the salary of \$20,000 per year. The rate of compensation for the members of the city council and the mayor may be changed by ordinance, except that no increase in such rate of compensation shall be made to become effective during the term of office of the members of council and the mayor in which the vote to increase the compensation is cast.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1988.
