

ORDINANCE NO. 3199

AN ORDINANCE making provision for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and providing supplemental appropriations required to defray certain expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for fiscal year 1987 which begins on the first day of July, 1986, and ends on the thirtieth day of June, 1987.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate unencumbered and unappropriated monies arising from the sale of the John Roberts and Parker Gray sites in the amount of \$832,543 from the General Fund "Sale of Surplus Property" account to the Capital Projects Fund. These appropriated monies are, at this time, planned for the following uses:

School construction	\$206,193
Note payment for	
Moore-Hill property	82,709
Annual payment to Northern	
Virginia Park Authority	254,418
Annual payment to Northern	
Virginia Community College	39,223
Payment to Braddock Place	250,000

Final authorization for the expenditure of these monies shall be subject to the approval by city council of specific allocation requests.

Section 2. That the city council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate unencumbered and unappropriated monies in the amount of \$1,500,000 from the General Fund accumulated "Undesignated Fund Balance" account to the Capital Projects Fund. These appropriated monies are, at this time, planned for the following uses:

Public works	\$585,193
Recreation	23,000
Public buildings	134,000
Schools	757,807

Final authorization for the expenditure of these monies shall be subject to the approval by city council of specific allocation requests.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing

the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet requests. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
