

ORDINANCE NO. 3213

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-6-22, Chapter 6, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 2 relates to GENERAL GOVERNMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to RECORDS MANAGEMENT, RETENTION AND DISPOSITION and which Section 2-6-22 relates to PUBLIC RECORDS ADVISORY COMMISSION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 2-6-22, Chapter 6, Title 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-6-22. Public records advisory commission.

A public records advisory commission is hereby established to provide advice and guidance to the city records administrator on records management matters and implementation of the records program in the city. The commission shall consist of seven (7) citizen members to be appointed by the city council, for terms of two (2) years, with membership composed, to the extent possible, of but not limited to professional archivists, records managers, historians and research specialists.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet requests. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
