

ORDINANCE NO. 3222

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 7-6-74 of Article E, Chapter 6, Title 7 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection (c); which Title 7 relates to PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, which Chapter 6 relates to ZONING, which Article E relates to OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING, which Section 7-6-74 relates to CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT and which new subsection (c) relates to VALET PARKING.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 7-6-74, Article E, Chapter 6, Title 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained by adding thereto subsection (c) as follows:

(c)(1) Within the central business district, no valet parking operation which involves the pick up, delivery, stacking, storing, parking or unparking of motor vehicles by a valet or parking attendant from, to or on any public right-of-way shall be permitted after July 1, 1987, as, or in connection with, any principal or accessory use of lands, buildings or structures.

(2) The provisions of subsection (c)(1) to the contrary notwithstanding, such valet parking operation may be permitted provided that:

a. the motor vehicles so served are parked, stored and unparked exclusively on an off-street parking area; and

b. a special use permit separately authorizing and governing such valet parking operation is applied for and granted pursuant to the provisions of Article J of this chapter.

Section 2. That the provisions of Section 1 to the contrary notwithstanding, any such valet parking operation which was lawfully being conducted on June 13, 1987, may continue to be conducted until October 1, 1987; provided, however, that such valet parking operation shall be conducted in such fashion as assures to the satisfaction of the Director of Transportation and Environmental Services that the vehicles so served are stopped on the public right-of-way only for such minimum period as is necessary to allow the occupants of such vehicles to alight from or enter into, and the valet or parking attendant to take or relinquish custody of, such vehicles, and remove same from the public right-of-way.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
