

ORDINANCE NO. 3233

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection (a) of Section 5-8-92 by adding a new subsection (17) and to amend and reordain Section 5-8-93, both of Division 1, Article G, Chapter 8, Title 5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended; which Title 5 relates to TRANSPORTATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, which Chapter 8 relates to PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, which Article G relates to PARKING METERS, which Division 1 relates to PARKING METER ZONES, which Section 5-8-93 relates to TIME LIMITS; WHEN METERS TO BE IN OPERATION; COINS DEPOSITED, which Section 5-8-92 relates to PARKING METER ZONES ESTABLISHED, which subsection (a) relates to PARKING METER ZONE 1 and which new subsection (17) relates to PRINCESS STREET.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 5-8-92 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new subsection (17) to read as follows:

(17) Both sides of the 700 and 800 blocks of Princess Street.

Section 2. That Section 5-8-93 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 5-8-93. Parking meters: hours and days of operation; maximum time limits; rates.

(a) The parking meters in zones 1 and 2, established by section 5-8-92 of this code, shall be operated every day of the week except Sundays and legal state holidays, and the daily hours of operation of the meters shall be determined by resolution of the city council.

(b) The maximum time limit for parking in any space in parking meter zones 1 and 2 shall be set forth on the meter for that space, and shall be 20 minutes, two hours or, in zone 1 only, four hours.

(c) In parking meter zone 1, the parking rates shall be as follows:

(1) On meters with a maximum time limit of 20 minutes, \$0.25 for 20 minutes;

(2) On meters with a maximum time limit of two hours, \$0.15 for any 12-minute period;

(3) On meters with a maximum time limit of four hours, \$0.25 for any 20-minute period.

(d) In parking meter zone 2, the parking rates shall be as follows:

(1) On meters with a maximum time limit of 20 minutes, \$0.10 for 20 minutes;

(2) On meters with a maximum time limit of two hours, \$0.10 for any 12-minute period.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet requests. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
