PLATES SHALL NOT BE ISSUED; DEALER TO FORWARD APPLICATION FOR CURRENT TITLING AND REGISTRATION; MISSTATEMENTS AND FALSE INFORMATION, which Section 10-3-112 relates to ALTERED OR FORGED LICENSE PLATES OR DECALS; USE AS EVIDENCE OF KNOWLEDGE, which Section 10-3-107 relates to HOW LICENSE PLATES FASTENED TO VEHICLE, which Section 10-3-106 relates to DISPLAY OF LICENSE PLATES, which Section 10-3-85 relates to ALTERING OR FORGING CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR REGISTRATION CARD, which Section 10-3-64 relates to OFFENSES RELATING TO REGISTRATION, LICENSING AND CERTIFICATES OF TITLE; NAME AND ADDRESS OF OWNER ON "FOR-HIRE" VEHICLE; NAME ON TRUCK, ETC. and which Section 10-3-37 relates to SIGNING AND POSSESSION OF REGISTRATION CARDS; EXHIBITING OF REGISTRATION CARD AND DRIVER'S, ETC., LICENSES; FAILURE TO CARRY LICENSE OR REGISTRATION CARD.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-37 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-37. Signing and possession of registration cards; exhibiting of registration card and driver's, etc., licenses; failure to carry license or registration card.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-7 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to signing and possession of registration cards, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 2. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-64 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-64. Offenses relating to registration, licensing and certificates of title; name and address of owner on "for-hire" vehicle; name on truck, etc.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-64 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to vehicle registration, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 3. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-85 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-85. Altering or forging certificate of title or registration card.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-85 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to altering or forging certificate of title or registration card, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 4. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-106 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-106. Display of license plates.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-106 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to display of license plates, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 5. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-107 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-107. How license plates fastened to vehicle.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-107 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to how license plates are fastened to the vehicle, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 6. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-112 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-112. Altered or forged license plates or decals; use as evidence of knowledge.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-112 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to altered or forged license plates or decals, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 7. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-124 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-124. To whom temporary plates shall not be issued; dealer to forward application for current titling and registration; misstatements and false information.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-124 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to whom temporary plates shall not be issued, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 8. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-167.3 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-167.3. Operating uninsured motor vehicle without payment of fee; furnishing certificate of insurance; false evidence of insurance.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-167.3 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to operating an uninsured motor vehicle, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 9. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-172 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-172. Riding upon or operating motorcycles.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-172 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to riding upon or operating motorcycles, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 10. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-172.01 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-172.01. Operating motorcycle without headlight, horn or rearview mirror.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-172.01 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to operating a motorcycle without proper equipment, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 11. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-173 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-173. Uniform marking and signing of highways; drivers to obey signs; enforcement of section.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-173 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to marking and signing highways, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 12. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-176 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-176. Duty of driver to stop, etc., in event of accident; duty of occupant; reports additional to other accident reports required by title.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-176 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to duty of the driver and of an occupant in the event of an accident, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 13. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-184 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-184. Signals by lights or other traffic control devices.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-184 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to signals by lights or other traffic control devices, is hereby adopted and incorporated

in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 14. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-189 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-189. Reckless driving; general rule.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-189 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to reckless driving generally, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 15. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-190 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-190. Reckless driving; specific instances.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-190 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to specific instances of reckless driving, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 16. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-192.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-192.1. Disregarding signal to stop by police officers; eluding police; penalties.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-192.1 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to disregarding a signal to stop by police officers, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 17. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-193 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-193. Maximum and minimum speed limits.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-193 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to speed limits, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 18. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-198.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-198.1. Prohibiting use of devices on motor vehicles to detect presence of radar upon highways or operation of motor vehicles so equipped or sale of such devices.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-198.1 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to prohibiting the use or sale of radar detection devices, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 19. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-202 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-202. Automobiles not to be equipped with television within view of operator of vehicle.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-202 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to autos equipped with television, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 20. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-202.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-202.1. Unlawful to operate automobile while using earphones.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-202.1 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to operating automobile while using earphones, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 21. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-203 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-203. Driving on right side of highway.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-203 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to driving on the right side of roads, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 22. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-204 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-204. One-way roadways and rotary traffic islands.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-204 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to one-way roadways and rotary traffic islands, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 23. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-206 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-206. Special regulations applicable on streets and highways laned for traffic.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-206 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to special regulations on laned highways, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 24. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-210 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-210. When overtaking vehicle may pass on right.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-210 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to when an overtaking vehicle may pass on the right, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 25. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-212 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-212. Limitations on privileges of overtaking and passing.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-212 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to limitations on privileges of overtaking and passing, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 26. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-212.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-212.1. Passing stopped school buses; penalty.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-212.1 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to passing stopped school buses, is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

Section 27. That Article B, Chapter 3, Title 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new Section 10-3-213 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-3-213. Following too closely.

Pursuant to the authority granted by section 46.1-188 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, section 46.1-213 of the Virginia Code, as amended, which relates to following too closely is hereby adopted and incorporated in its entirety into this chapter as if it were fully set forth herein.

That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet requests. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective on the date of its final passage.
