

ORDINANCE NO. 3279

AN ORDINANCE making provision for the support of the government of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and providing supplemental appropriations required to defray certain expenditures and liabilities of the municipal corporation for fiscal year 1988 which begins on the first day of July 1987 and ends on the thirtieth day of June 1988.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the city council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate unencumbered and unappropriated monies in the amount of \$4,000,000 from the General Fund accumulated "Undesignated Fund Balance" account to the Capital Projects Fund. These appropriated monies are, at this time, planned for the following uses:

Substance Abuse Services	
Center/Homeless Shelter	\$2,700,000
Fruit Growers Express site acquisition	\$1,300,000

Authorization for the actual expenditure of these monies shall require the approval of specific allocation requests by city council.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet requests. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
