

ORDINANCE NO. 3339

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (3) (COMPUTATION OF TIME) of Section 1-1-5 (RULES OF CONSTRUCTION AND DEFINITIONS) by designating the existing language of subsection (3) as subsection (a) and adding a new subsubsection (b), all of Chapter 1 (USE AND INTRODUCTION), Title 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (3) of Section 1-1-5 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(3) Computation of time.

(a) Whenever a notice is required to be given, or an act to be done, a certain length of time before any proceeding shall be had, the day on which such notice is given, or such act is done, shall be counted in computing the time, but the day on which such proceeding is to be had shall not be counted.

(b) Except as may otherwise be expressly provided by law, when the last day fixed by any provision of this code or by administrative regulation for the commencement of any proceeding, for a paper to be served, delivered, filed, or recorded, or for any other act to be done, in connection with any regulatory proceeding before any city officer, board, commission or agency, or before the city council, falls on a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday observed by the Commonwealth of Virginia, or any other day on which the city manager authorizes the closing of city offices, the proceeding may be commenced, the paper may be served, delivered, filed or recorded, or the act may be done on the next succeeding day that it is not a Saturday, Sunday, or such legal holiday or other day on which city offices are closed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
