

ORDINANCE NO. 3351

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (a) of Section 7-6-214 (PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF CHAPTER; INJUNCTIONS), Article L (ADMINISTRATION; PENALTY), Chapter 6 (ZONING), Title 7 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a) of Section 7-6-214 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall upon conviction, if the offense is not willful, be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100, and if the offense is willful, by a fine of not more than \$250, and in every case, \$10 for each day after the first day that such violation shall continue; provided, further, that if the violation involves the unauthorized demolition in whole or in part of any building or structure within an historic district, or of any building listed for preservation pursuant to article N, the fine shall be \$1,000.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
