

ORDINANCE NO. 3367

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (1) of Section 7-6-44 (* * * OUTDOOR DISPLAY OR STORAGE OF GOODS OR MERCHANDISE) of Article C (ADDITIONAL USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS), Chapter 6 (ZONING), Title 7 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (1) of Section 7-6-44 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(1) Outdoor display or storage of goods or merchandise. The outdoor display or storage of goods or merchandise is prohibited on public rights-of-way and pedestrian circulation facilities, on private streets, alleys, roadways and driveways, and on off-street parking and loading areas; provided, that a person conducting a business in a building adjacent to a public sidewalk may, in conjunction with a bona fide sale and in accordance with a temporary permit issued by the city manager or her designee, display or store goods or merchandise from that business on a portion of the sidewalk that is contiguous to the building. Any person desiring such a permit shall apply to the city manager or her designee who may issue the permit upon a finding that the proposed display or storage of goods or merchandise will not endanger the safety, and will not be inconsistent with the welfare and convenience, of the public and upon the execution of an agreement in which the person seeking the permit agrees to defend and hold the city harmless from any and all claims, demands, losses, liability, causes of action, costs and expenses of any kind arising from or incident to any activity undertaken under the permit by such person or any employee or agent of the business for whose benefit the permit is issued. Each permit issued under this subsection shall be valid only for the duration of the sale in conjunction with which it is issued or seven days, whichever is less. No more than four permits may be issued under this subsection in any one year to the same person or to any person associated with the same business.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
