

ORDINANCE NO. 3489

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Sections 2-2-1 (DIVISION OF CITY INTO WARDS), 2-2-2 (WARD BOUNDARIES--FIRST WARD), 2-2-3 (SAME--SECOND WARD), 2-2-4 (SAME--THIRD WARD), 2-2-5 (SAME--FOURTH WARD), 2-2-6 (SAME--FIFTH WARD), 2-2-7 (SAME--SIXTH WARD), 2-2-8 (SAME--SEVENTH WARD) and 2-2-9 (SAME--EIGHTH WARD), and to amend and reordain Sections 2-2-10 (ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES) and 2-2-13 (MAP OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES), all of Chapter 2 (ELECTIONS), Title 2 (GENERAL GOVERNMENT) of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Sections 2-2-1, 2-2-2, 2-2-3, 2-2-4, 2-2-5, 2-2-6, 2-2-7, 2-2-8 and 2-2-9 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 2. That Section 2-2-10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-2-10 Establishment of election districts and voting places

(a) The Lyles Crouch School Election district shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the southern city boundary crosses the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of Wolfe Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wolfe Street to the centerline of South St. Asaph Street; thence southward along the centerline of St. Asaph Street to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to Hunting Creek; thence westward along the north line of Hunting Creek to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Lyles Crouch School Election District shall be at the Lyles Crouch School located at 530 South St. Asaph Street.

(b) The City Hall Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Washington and Wolfe Streets; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wilkes

Street to the centerline of St. Asaph Street; thence northward along the centerline of St. Asaph Street to the centerline of Wolfe Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wolfe Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the City Hall Election District shall be in the lobby of the King Street entrance to city hall.

(c) The Pendleton House Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Washington and Oronoco Streets; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the northern boundary of the city; thence eastward along the north city boundary to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence westward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Pendleton House Election District shall be at the Pendleton House located at 399 Pendleton Street.

(d) The George Mason School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Braddock Road and Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Russell Road; thence southward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Lloyd's Lane; thence westward along the centerline of Lloyd's Lane to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence northward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the George Mason School Election District shall be at the George Mason School located at the east side of Cameron Mills Road, between Virginia Avenue and Monticello Boulevard.

(e) The Beverley Hills Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Four Mile Run and the centerline of Mount Vernon Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Mount Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence southward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad; thence due north to the northern city boundary at Four Mile Run;

thence eastward along the northern city boundary to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Beverley Hills Election District shall be at the Beverley Hills Community Center, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Old Dominion Boulevard and Tennessee Avenue.

(f) The Barrett School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Chalfonte Drive and Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad; thence due north to the northern city boundary at Four Mile Run; thence westward along the northern city boundary to the western boundary of the city; thence southward along the western boundary of the city to the centerline of Preston Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Preston Road to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Gunston Road; thence southward along the centerline of Gunston Road to the centerline of Chalfonte Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Chalfonte Drive to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Barrett School Election District shall be at the Barrett School, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Valley Drive and the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad.

(g) The Agudas Achim Congregation Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Chalfonte Drive and Cameron Mills Road; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Wellington Road; thence southward along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence southward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the Western city boundary at Quaker Lane; thence northward along the city boundary to the centerline of Preston Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Preston Road to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Gunston Road; thence southward along the centerline of Gunston Road to the centerline of Chalfonte Drive; thence eastward along Chalfonte Drive to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Agudas Achim Congregation Election District shall be at the Agudas Achim Congregation, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Valley Drive and Allison Street.

(h) The Jefferson Houston School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along this right-of-way line to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the centerline of Washington Street; thence southward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Jefferson Houston School Election District shall be at the Jefferson Houston School, located on the north side of Cameron Street at the intersection of Cameron Street and North West Street.

(i) The Engine Company No. 4 Fire House Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Oronoco Street and Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the northern city boundary; thence westward on said boundary to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward on the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Monroe Avenue; thence southward along the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Engine Company No. 4 Fire House Election District shall be at the Engine Company No. 4 Fire House located at the intersection of Powhatan and Second Streets.

(j) The MacArthur School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the centerline of Quaker Lane intersects with a line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Radford Street; thence southward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline

of King Street to the line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence westward along such line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the MacArthur School Election District shall be the MacArthur School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Janney's Lane and Yale Drive.

All persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, and whose residences bear a Janney's Lane mailing address are included within the MacArthur School Election District.

(k) The Second Presbyterian Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where a line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane intersects with the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the western right-of-way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along the right-of-way line to the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of North Quaker Lane to the line 50 feet south of the centerline of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence eastward along such line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Second Presbyterian Church Election District shall be the Second Presbyterian Church, at 1400 Janney's Lane.

Those persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, but who do not have a Janney's Lane mailing address, are included within the Second Presbyterian Church Election District, even though a portion of their residences may not be within the boundary of that district.

(l) The Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Washington Street to the centerline of King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along such right-of-way line to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to Cameron Run; thence eastward with Cameron Run to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence

southward with the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973; thence eastward along such boundary to the centerline of Hooff's Run; thence northward along the centerline of Hooff's Run to a point where it would intersect with a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward in a straight line to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Alfred Street Baptist Church Election District shall be at the Alfred Street Baptist Church, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Duke Street and South Alfred Street.

(m) The Lee Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to its end; thence westward along a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street to the centerline of Hooff's Run; thence southward along the centerline of Hooff's Run to the southern city boundary; thence eastward along such boundary to the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Washington Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Lee Center Election District shall be at the Lee Center, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Patrick Street and Jefferson Street.

(n) The Maury School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along such right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch parkway; thence southward on a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street, such line being perpendicular to King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Maury School Election District shall be the Maury School, located on the west side of Russell Road between Rucker Place and Walnut Street.

(o) The Blessed Sacrament Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Braddock Road and Radford Street; thence northward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence to the centerline of Wellington Road; thence northward along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Blessed Sacrament Church Election District shall be the Blessed Sacrament Church, located at 1427 West Braddock Road.

(p) The Chinquapin Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and Radford Street; thence northward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward along a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street, such line being perpendicular to King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Chinquapin Election District shall be the Chinquapin Park Recreation Center, 3210 King Street.

(q) The George Washington School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence southward along such right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the George Washington School Election District shall be the George Washington School, located on the east side of Mount Vernon Avenue between Glendale Avenue and Braddock Road.

(r) The Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along such right-of-way line to the centerline of Monroe Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence westward along the centerline of Lloyd's Lane to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be the Immanuel Lutheran Church, 1801 Russell Road.

(s) The No. 2 Firehouse Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Bellefonte Avenue and Jefferson Davis Highway; thence westward along the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline of Clyde Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Clyde Avenue to the centerline of Uhler Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Uhler Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the No. 2 Firehouse Election District shall be the No. 2 Firehouse located at the south side of Windsor Avenue between Mt. Vernon Avenue and De Witt Avenue.

(t) The Mt. Vernon School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Mt. Ida Avenue and Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Reed Avenue; thence along the center line of Reed

Avenue to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Hume Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Hume Avenue to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline of Uhler Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Uhler Avenue to the centerline of Clyde Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Clyde Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Mt. Vernon School Election District shall be at the Mt. Vernon School located at the west side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, between Uhler Avenue and Randolph Street.

(u) The Cora Kelly School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Hume Avenue and Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Reed Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Reed Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the northern city boundary; thence eastward along such boundary to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Hume Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Hume Avenue to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Cora Kelly School Election District shall be at the Cora Kelly School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Reed Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue.

(v) The Alexandria School Administration Office Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of North Quaker Lane and Seminary Road; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the Arlington county line to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of such highway to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Alexandria School Administration Office Election District shall be the Alexandria School

Administration Office, located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Braddock Road and North Early Street.

(w) The Francis Hammond High School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of the intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway with the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of North Pickett Street; thence southward along the centerline of North Pickett Street to the intersection with the centerline of North Pegram Street; thence westward and southward along the centerline of North Pegram Street to a point on an imaginary line on the eastward extension of the centerline of Maris Avenue; thence westward along said imaginary line on the centerline of Maris Avenue to the intersection of the westward extension of said imaginary line and the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Francis Hammond High School Election District shall be the Francis Hammond High School, 4646 Seminary Road.

(x) The James K. Polk School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Seminary Road with the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the centerline of North Jordan Street to the centerline of Taney Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Taney Avenue to the east boundary of the Patrick Henry School property; thence northward along the east boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to the northeast corner of such property; thence westward along the north boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to the northwest corner of such property; thence southward along the west boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to its intersection with the centerline of Taney Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Taney Avenue to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of such highway to its intersection with an imaginary line on the westward extension of the centerline of Maris Avenue; thence eastward along said imaginary line on the centerline of Maris Avenue to the intersection of the eastward extension of said imaginary line with the centerline of North Pegram Street; thence northward and eastward along the centerline of North Pegram Street to the centerline of North Pickett Street; thence along the centerline of North Pickett Street to the intersection of the said line with the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the James K. Polk School Election District shall be the James K. Polk School, 5000 Polk Avenue.

(y) The Patrick Henry School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway with the centerline of Taney Avenue; thence eastward along the north boundary of such property to its northeast corner; thence southward along the eastern boundary of such property to its intersection with the centerline of Taney Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Taney Avenue to the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the centerline of North Jordan Street to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Patrick Henry School Election District shall be the Patrick Henry School, located on the north side of Taney Avenue between Latham Street and Howard Street.

(z) The Oakwood Apartments Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and the centerline of Duke Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of South Pickett Street; thence southward along the centerline of South Pickett Street to the centerline of South Van Dorn Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Van Dorn Street to the centerline of Edsall Road; thence westward along the centerline of Edsall Road to the centerline of South Whiting Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Whiting Street to the centerline of Stevenson Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Stevenson Avenue to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northeastward along the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place for Oakwood Apartments Election District shall be at the Oakwood Apartments Clubhouse, located at 140 South Van Dorn Street.

(aa) The Trade Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Cameron Run and the southern boundary of the city as established January 1, 1973; northward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the centerline of South Jordan Street; thence northeastward along the centerline of South

Jordan Street to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of South Pickett Street; thence southward along the centerline of South Pickett Street to the centerline of South Van Dorn Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Van Dorn Street to the centerline of Edsall Road; then westward along the centerline of Edsall Road to the centerline of South Whiting Street; thence northward along the centerline of South Whiting Street to the centerline of Stevenson Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Stevenson Avenue to the western city boundary; thence southward along the western city boundary and eastward along the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973, to the point of beginning.

The voting place for the Trade Center Election District shall be the Trade Center, located at 350 South Pickett Street.

(bb) The Temple Beth El Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of South Quaker Lane and the southern boundary of the city as established January 1, 1973; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Cameron Run; thence westwardly with the centerline of Cameron Run to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of North Quaker Lane to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence westward along the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the centerline of North and South Jordan Streets to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to the centerline of Cameron Run; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the centerline of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right-of-way; thence southwestward along the centerline of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right-of-way to the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973; thence eastward along the southern boundary of the city to the point of beginning.

The voting place within Temple Beth El Election District shall be Temple Beth El, 3830 Seminary Road.

(cc) The John Tyler Building Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of Seminary Road with the centerline of North Beauregard Street; thence northward along the centerline of North Beauregard Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence south along the

centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the Arlington County line to the western boundary of the city; thence southward along the western boundary of the city to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the John Tyler Building Election District shall be the John Tyler Building, located at 3101 North Beauregard Street.

(dd) The William Ramsay School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway with the western boundary of the city; thence northward along the western boundary of the city to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to its intersection with the north property line of the William Ramsay School property site; thence eastward along the north property line to the centerline of Sanger Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Sanger Avenue to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the William Ramsay School Election District shall be at the William Ramsay School, located at 5700 Sanger Avenue.

(ee) The John Adams Middle School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and Seminary Road; thence westerly along the centerline of Seminary Road to the western boundary of the city; thence westerly along the present boundary line to the intersection of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to its intersection with the north property line of the William Ramsay School property site; thence eastward along the north line to the centerline of Sanger Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Sanger Avenue to the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the John Adams Middle School Election District shall be at the John Adams Middle School on Rayburn Avenue.

(ff) The Southern Towers Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the centerlines of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and Seminary Road; thence northward along the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence north along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of North Beauregard Street; thence southward along the centerline of North Beauregard Street to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Southern Towers Election District shall be at the Southern Towers Apartments, 4901 Seminary Road.

Section 3. That Section 2-2-13 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1981, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-2-13 Map of election districts and voting places.

The city manager shall have prepared an official map showing the election districts and the voting places designated by this chapter. This map shall be designated "The Official Map of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, Designating Election Districts and Voting Places," and shall be signed by the mayor, attested to by the clerk, and the official seal of the city shall be impressed thereon.

The original of such map shall be deposited with the general registrar for the city and shall be available to the public for inspection. Whenever there are any changes in the election districts or voting places, except temporary voting places as provided for in the preceding section, another such official map shall be prepared.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be enacted upon the date and at the time of its final passage but shall not become effective until March 1, 1991.
