

ORDINANCE NO. 3491

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Alexandria to establish and maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way of 107 South Alfred Street, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is the owner of the Friendship Firehouse building located at 107 South Alfred Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria desires to establish and maintain a pair of front doors on the Friendship Firehouse building, each door being four feet in height, which, when permitted to swing outward, will encroach into the public right-of-way by two feet, ten inches; and

WHEREAS, the public right-of-way at that point on 107 South Alfred Street will not be significantly impaired by this encroachment; and

WHEREAS, this encroachment has been approved by the Planning Commission of the City of Alexandria at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the City of Alexandria that this encroachment is not detrimental to the public interest; therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Alexandria be, and hereby is, authorized to establish and maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way at 107 South Alfred Street in the City of Alexandria, said encroachment consisting of a pair of front doors, in the Friendship Firehouse, each door being four feet in height, which, when opened, will extend outward into the public right-of-way by two feet ten inches, until the encroachment is removed or destroyed or the authorization to maintain it is terminated by the city.

Section 2. That nothing in this ordinance is intended to constitute, or shall be deemed to be, a waiver of sovereign immunity by or on behalf of the City of Alexandria.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be effective upon the date and at the time of its final passage.
