

RESOLUTION NO. 36

WHEREAS, the proposed expansion of the Alexandria Hospital may precipitate the closing of the Duke Street Hospital facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria is deeply concerned about the provision of adequate comprehensive health services in downtown Alexandria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Alexandria, as a matter of policy, commit itself to the provision of easily accessible comprehensive outpatient health care facilities to be located in Eastern Alexandria, said facilities to be delivered on a schedule which would render them operational at a time concurrent with the curtailing of any of the outpatient services presently being rendered by the Duke Street Hospital facility.

This Council recognizes that a study of the Community Health care needs is underway and will be completed within this year and that findings of that study will be made a part of this policy statement.
